INTERIM ORDER

1. The matter was heard by the Commission on 1st July, 2019, as scheduled.
2. The Learned Counsel for LANCO submitted brief facts of the case seeking consequential order in terms of judgement dated 22nd May 2019, passed by Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal of Electricity wherein the Hon'ble Tribunal, has allowed the interest payment to LANCO by HPPC on the principal amount of

Rs. 88.123 crore from the date of commencement of supply (07.05.2011) and also directed the Commission to pass an order as expeditiously as possible within a period of three months after receiving the copy of this judgement.

3. The learned counsel for the Respondent No 1-PTC sought leave to make written submission at appropriate time in future and further submitted that the matter may be decided according to regulations and in a time bound manner.
4. The learned counsel for the Respondent No 2- HPPC also sought some time to file written reply in the matter.
5. Acceding to the request of the Respondent, the Commission grants leave to respondents to submit their written reply within two weeks, failing which it shall be presumed that Respondents have nothing to submit in the matter and the Commission shall proceed to pass final order in line with the decision of Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal of Electricity vide its order dated 22.05.2019. No extension of time will be granted to Respondents for submission of written replies.
6. The matter shall now be heard on 9th September, 2019 at 11:15 AM.
