INTERIM ORDER

- 1) The matter was heard today, as scheduled.
- 2) The Counsel for petitioner has requested for sanction of power supply at 132 KV level instead of 33 KV level and made short submissions by way of affidavit. In para 5, he has proposed to take LILO connection from 132 KV line between 132 KV Sub Station Kosli and 132 KV Sub-Station Dadri.
- 3) Sh. Vishal Sharma XEN appearing on behalf of HVPNL, states that they have examined the request of the petitioner. However, it is not feasible to give connectivity as per the proposal of the petitioner. HVPNL can provide the connection from 220 KV Sub-station Dadibana.
- 4) Sh. Rajesh Arora, Deputy Secretary, on behalf of UHBVNL states that Distribution Licensee has no issue so long as it is feasible to give connectivity by HVPNL.
- 5) In order to arrive at technically feasible outcome, HVPNL is directed to share the information along with expenditure involved with the petitioner on which petitioner can give his response. Thereafter the matter will be taken up for consideration by the Commission.
