ORDER

1. The case was heard on 07/04/2026, as scheduled, in the court room of the Commission.

5. Acceding to request of the petitioner, the Commission allowed to withdraw the instant petition and file fresh petition. The petitioner is exempted from depositing the fee on submission of fresh petition.
