Petition under sections 86(1)(e), 86(1)(f) and 86(1)(e) of the electricity act, 2003 read with regulations 65, 66, 67 and 68 of the HERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2019 seeking directions from this Hon'ble Commission for settlement of energy generated by the petitioner no. 1 during the intervening period when scheduling was prevented due to non-availability of a qualified coordinating agency on account of difficulty arising from clause 6(v) of the procedure for forecasting, scheduling and deviation settlement of solar & wind generation as approved by the commission, and in the alternative, seeking directions for compensation of such energy at the average power purchase price (APPC) applicable to the concerned distribution licensee, by exercise of the Commission's power to relax and/or power to remove difficulty along with supporting affidavit.
