Petition under the Regulation 81, 82 and 84 read with Regulation 68.1 (2) of the Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Generation, Transmission, Wheeling and Distribution & Retail Supply under Multi Year Tariff Framework) Regulations, 2024 (hereinafter referred to as MYT Regulations, 2024) read with Regulation 23 and 71 of the Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2019 invoking removal of difficulty/ relaxation of Regulation 68 of MYT Regulations, 2024 seeking exemption from charging of Fuel and Power Purchase Adjustment Surcharge (FPPAS) on monthly basis for FY 2025-26 and allow recovery of same alongwith carrying cost in subsequent Financial Years on uniform per unit basis across all consumer categories.

INTERIM ORDER

2. At the outset, Shri Raghujeet Madan, the learned counsel appearing for the

petitioners, sought liberty to file reply to the comments of the intervenors in the matter.

3. Upon hearing the parties, the Commission observes that more clarity and information in the matter is required from the petitioner(s). Accordingly, the Commission directs the petitioner(s) to file the following details:-
 - a. FPPAs recoverable as on 31.03.2026, from consumers as well as from State Government, for each year i.e. FY 2022-23, FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25.
 - b. Complete status of the recovery of FPPAs done and plan for the outstanding recovery of FPPAs along with the recovery plan of FPPAS for the FY 2025-26.
 - c. Complete details of circumstances / prior period expenses leading to FPPA in the month of November, 2025.
4. The intervenors are allowed to file any additional comments within one week from the date of this order with copy to the petitioners. The discoms are directed to file their reply on all the comments filed by stakeholders within two weeks, thereafter, with copy to the intervenors.
5. The case shall be listed for arguments on 10.06.2026.
