INTERIM ORDER

1. The case was taken up for hearing on 14.05.2026, as scheduled, in the courtroom of the Commission.
2. Upon hearing the parties, the Commission directs the petitioner is directed to provide the following information/documents on affidavit within two weeks from the date of issuance of this order:-

- a) A certificate confirming that the bidding process was conducted in compliance with the Ministry of Power Bidding Guidelines dated 10.03.2022 and VGF Guidelines dated 17.10.2024 and that no deviation from the said Guidelines was made.
 - b) Copies of the newspaper advertisements published in respect of the aforesaid bidding process.
 - c) Considering two hours battery discharge cycle and land being provided by the Nigam, a justification demonstrating that the tariff discovered through the bidding process is competitive and reasonable in the prevailing market conditions, giving reference of the tariff discovered in other States by suitably amending the same to the conditions of the present tender.
 - d) The entity responsible for charge and discharge BESS as well as the power rate at which battery shall be charged during night hours.
3. The case shall be listed for arguments on 10.06.2026.
