**Subject: Application under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 (i) to give instruction to DHBVN to provide a direct electricity connection to me under Domestic Supply (DS) Category in place of current electricity connection under Option – 1 of the Single Point Supply Connection 1 (Bulk Supply Domestic) so that I could avail the subsidy benefits in electricity tariff announced by the Chief Minister of Haryana on 11.09.2018 for Domestic Supply (DS) Category consumers of the state, or (ii) to give direction to Additional Chief Secretary to Government of Haryana, Power Department to treat my electricity connection under Option – 1 of the Single Point Supply Regulations, 2013 as a Domestic Supply (DS) Category consumer and accordingly give instruction to DHBVN so that I could get eligible and entitle to receive subsidy in power tariff wef 01.10.2018 as announced by the Chief Minister of Haryana on 11.09.2018.**

3. Shri Joginder Singh XEN Commercial, DHBVNL appeared on the behalf of the Respondent No. 1 (DHBVNL), explained that the separate

connection to the Petitioner cannot be given under option 2 of Single Point Supply Regulation 2013 and its amendments since the entire society members has to exercise option either to go for option 1 or option 2 for supply of power by distribution licensee as per the regulation in-vogue.

4. The commission directed the respondent to explore the feasibility of supply of power to the petitioner from licensee's distribution network provided; the petitioner meets the expenditure in providing the supply by extending the distribution system. The demand notice may be issued after looking into the feasibility and preparation of estimate.
