INTERIM ORDER

1. The case was heard by the Commission on 01.05.2019, as scheduled.
2. The counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner informed that the petition has been filed seeking determination of tariff of its 97 MW, Tashiding Hydro Electric Project, West District, Sikkim, in pursuant to the PPA approved by the Commission vide its Order dated 30.11.2017 & 08.03.2019 in Case No. HERC/PRO-25 of 2017.
3. During the course of the hearing, Ld. Advocate for the respondent submitted that no PPA has been signed between the parties in pursuant to the Order of the Commission dated 08.03.2019. Therefore, without a formal agreement between the parties i.e. signed PPA, the exercise for tariff determination would be futile. He further argued that a petition no. HERC/RA-7 of 2019, has been filed by respondent seeking review against the order of the Commission approving the PPA and unless the same is decided, the PPA cannot be signed. Therefore, he sought adjournment of proceedings till the PPA is signed between the parties after order of the Commission on the review petition.
4. The Commission, therefore, agreeing with the submission of the respondent, directs the parties to submit the copy of signed PPA in terms of the approval granted by the Commission vide its Order dated 08.03.2019, within 15 days of the date of disposal of Review Petition No. HERC/RA-7 of 2019. Further, the proceedings in the instant petition for determination of Tariff shall be taken up after the receipt of signed PPA.
5. The next date of hearing shall be intimated separately.
6. This order is signed, dated and issued by the Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission on 14.05.2019.
