**INTERIM ORDER**

1. The case was heard by the Commission on 01.10.2019, as scheduled.
2. The counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner informed that the petition has been filed seeking determination of tariff of its 97 MW, Tashiding Hydro Electric Project, West District, Sikkim, in pursuant to the PPA approved by the Commission vide its Order dated 30.11.2017 & 08.03.2019 in Case No. HERC/PRO-25 of 2017.
3. Per contra, Ld. Advocate for the respondent submitted that no PPA has been signed between the parties pursuant to the Order of the Commission dated 08.03.2019. Therefore, without a formal agreement between the parties i.e. signed PPA, the exercise for tariff determination would be futile. He further argued that an appeal in the matter has been filed in the Hon'ble Appellate Tribunal for Electricity against the Order of this Commission in petition no. HERC/RA-7 of 2019 and the same is pending adjudication. Therefore, he sought adjournment of proceedings till the disposal of the said appeal.

4. The Commission, in view of the submission of the respondent regarding appeal being filed in the matter, orders that the matter shall now be heard on 27.11.2019 at 11.30 A.M.
