INTERIM ORDER

1. The case was heard on 08/01/2025, as scheduled, in the court room of the Commission.
2. Sh. Akshay Gupta counsel for the petitioner submitted that the orders dated 30/08/2024 of the CGRF have been complied except for the penal interest at the rate of 18% for the period for which payment of interest accrued on ACD is delayed and interest on the ToD/ToU rebate at rate of 9% for the period for which rebate is delayed.
3. The SDO, Meham present in the court submitted that the orders of the CGRF have been complied but the interest part claimed by the petitioner was not part of the CGRF order.
4. To the query of the Commission whether the penal interest/interest demanded by the petitioner is payable as per sales circulars, the SDO, Meham replied in affirmative and sought two weeks' time to pay the penal interest part also.
5. After hearing both the parties, the Commission directs the respondent to pay the penal interest as discussed above and file a compliance report within two weeks i.e. upto 22.01.2024, otherwise penalty will be imposed on the respondent as per regulations.
6. The matter to come up next on 18/02/2025.
