**INTERIM ORDER**

1. The case was heard by the Commission on 30.09.2019, as scheduled.
2. Smt. Sonia Madan, Advocate, Ld. Counsel for the Respondent, argued that the Petitioner has not provided the relevant documents to arrive at the reasonable capital cost and other tariff components, as directed by the Commission in its Order dated 30.04.2019 in case no. HERC/PRO-20 of 2019.
3. Shri R.K. Jain, Advisor, appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, mainly reiterated the contents of its Petition, which for the sake of brevity have not been reproduced. Shri Jain further argued that the documents in support of actual fixed cost and

other tariff components for determining project specific tariff will be provided only after achieving financial closure and for which atleast an indicative tariff is required by the financial institutions. Therefore, an indicative tariff may be given, based on the parameters specified in the HERC RE Regulations, 2017, for biomass (Non-Baggase) based power project based on water cooled condenser.

4. Upon hearing the parties, the Commission finds some merit in the arguments of the Petitioner that an indicative tariff is necessary for achieving financial closure. Accordingly, the Commission shall decide generic tariff for such projects to be set up in Haryana during the control period from FY 2018-19 to FY 2020-21. The generic tariff shall be subject to true-up on availability of actual project cost and other parameters, as and when the project of the Petitioner attains CoD, subject to the prudence check by the Commission.
